



Natural gas leak warning lifted in Ypsilanti Township

A "shelter advisory" warning has been lifted in Ypsilanti Township, meaning residents near a natural gas main leak can now venture outdoors.

The Washtenaw County Emergency Operations Center had earlier issued a warning about the leak in the area of Holmes Road and Jerome Street in Ypsilanti Township.

At about noon, residents within a one-block area of the scene were told to stay indoors and keep doors and windows shut due to the leak.
