



Workers go door to door to restore natural gas service

CENTERVILLE, Ohio (AP) -- Natural gas service has been restored to most Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio customers in Centerville.

Workers went door-to-door Saturday to restore service to 575 customers after an equipment failure shut down the flow of natural gas.

Spokeswoman Chase Kelley says a mechanical failure at a regulator station caused pressure to build in the system on Friday. A safety valve released and stopped the flow of gas to homes along a portion of Ohio Route 48.

After the part was repaired, workers starting the tedious process of turning on individual meters and re-lighting pilot lights.

Vectren delivers natural gas to 318,000 customers in 17 western Ohio counties.
